To All SA Groups with Members Having Three Years Or More Sobriety:

Dear Friends,

The SA manual has been revised and is now in process of being edited and printed as a six-by-nine-inch paperback book. There will be no more printings of the existing 8 1/2 x 11 manual, which has now been considerably revised and the original of which is getting too tattered to print as before. Thus, when existing supplies of the "white book" run out, they will be replaced by the new paperback edition.

We are considering the feasibility of including member stories in the forthcoming edition.

I have asked Nan to send this memo to all established SA groups (and loners) which may have members with three or more years of sexual sobriety. If you know of such groups that may not have been contacted by Nan, please advise her at the Central Office immediately or give them a copy of this letter.

I am asking for submittals from the fellowship to see if stories available at this time are suitable for representing the principles of SA recovery to those still suffering.

The following are story submittal requirements:

1. The individual must be an established member of SA.
2. The member must have three or more years of uninterrupted sexual sobriety as commonly understood by the fellowship as described in the SA literature.
3. Quality of the individual's sobriety and recovery must be recognized and validated by the other members in the individual's fellowship. *It is the group/intergroup that submits the story(s).* Stories of loners should be submitted through their sponsor(s).
4. Where possible, submittals should be typed, double-spaced, not to exceed four double-spaced pages, preferably less. (*Please* have it typed if at all possible.) Stories will be subject to editing and condensation.
5. No name should appear on the manuscript, but the author should be identified in a cover letter or note from the submitting group or intergroup to the Central Office so submittals can be read "blind."
6. All stories must be received at the Central Office *before 6 April 1989.* Time is of the essence.

Thank you for your help, and may God grant us the knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.
